Export Documentation Checklist

Every shipment we send is accompanied by a standard documentation set. Requirements vary slightly by destination country and product, but this covers what to expect and why each document matters.

Document	Purpose
Commercial Invoice	States value, quantity and terms of sale for customs valuation
Packing List	Details how goods are packed, weights and dimensions per package
Bill of Lading / Airway Bill	Proof of shipment and title document issued by the carrier
Certificate of Origin	Confirms goods originate from India, may enable preferential duty rates
Phytosanitary Certificate	Required for plant-based goods, confirms freedom from pests and disease
Fumigation Certificate	Required when wood packaging (pallets/crates) is used in the shipment
Insurance Certificate	Provided when shipping under CIF or CIP terms
Quality / Lab Test Report	Confirms product meets agreed specification before loading
FSSAI / Health Certificate	Confirms compliance with Indian food safety regulations

Destination-Specific Requirements

Some markets add further requirements — for example, US shipments may need FDA Prior Notice, and EU shipments may require specific pesticide-residue documentation. Tell us your destination country when requesting a quote and we'll confirm the exact document set upfront, before you place an order.
